## CONTINUATION SHEET

1. **QUESTION:** There is a mixing valve shown on detail 5 "Mechanical Building New Work Domestic Plan" on drawing P-104 labeled MV-1. Mixing valve MV-1 is also shown on detail 1 on drawing P-502. There is no schedule showing any sizing or performance requirements. Please clarify requirements of mixing valve MV-1.

**ANSWER:** See P-601 for MV schedule and Specification 22 00 00 paragraph 2.11.

2. **QUESTION:** Section 23 73 33, paragraph 2.4.4 "Buried Preinsulated Water Piping" calls for heating hot water to have prefabricated fittings. Historically on Camp Lejeune projects, we have provided field supplied fittings that are field insulated with factory supplied fitting insulation kits. Will prefabricated fittings be required?

**ANSWER:** Field supplied fittings with field insulated with factory supplied insulation kits is acceptable.

3. **QUESTION:** There are no specifications for the underground chilled water piping, underground domestic hot water, and underground domestic hot water return. Will these services be pre-insulated? If so, what types of materials are we to use? Will pre-insulated pipe with field supplied fittings and factory supplied fitting insulation kits be allowed? Please clarify.

**ANSWER:** Specification 23 73 33 2.4.4 applies to all buried underground piping. Omit heating hot from this paragraph.

4. **QUESTION:** Section 22 000 00, paragraph 2.8 "Water Heaters" says water heaters "shall be non-condensing, natural gas fired with integral storage tank". Note 2 on the Domestic Water Heater schedule on drawing P-601 says to "provide boilers". We have not found any manufacturer of domestic water boilers that meet the requirements of an integral storage tank other than PVI Water Heaters. Other domestic water boilers have integral storage tanks but only when steam fired. Are we to provide PVI water heaters, which are far more expensive, for this project or will domestic water boilers with separate storage tanks be acceptable? If the government is requiring natural gas fire with integral storage tank, please provide alternate sources other than PVI.

**ANSWER:** Condensing or Non-Condensing water heaters are allowed. Boilers and storage tanks are not acceptable.

**5. QUESTION:** Does the washing machine chase receive FRP?

ANSWER: No.

**6. QUESTION:** Past BEQs have had allowances for FF&E as well as a CLIN for the design. Will that be required on this one?

**ANSWER:** Bid as per plan and specs.

7. **QUESTION:** Please provide specifications for light gauge steel trusses.

**ANSWER:** Contractor shall conform to the requirements of Section 05 40 00 "COLDFORMED METAL FRAMING" and the drawings.

8. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
