Is your hotel Connected Room-ready?

NETWORK

- ☐ Deploy UnoNet
You'll install UnoNet at the time of your StayConnected install or next scheduled refresh
- ☐ Maintain a minimum circuit size per Section 710.03 of your brand standards

TELEVISION

- ☐ Install Category 6 (Cat6) cabling behind each guestroom TV
- ☐ Install Coax cabling behind each guestroom TV
- ☐ Deploy a headend-based free-to-guest system
Set-top box and IPTV solutions are incompatible with Connected Room
- ☐ Remove any on demand or streaming/casting solutions
- ☐ Ensure at least one outlet behind the TV receives constant power
- ☐ Purchase hospitality TVs with HDMI and MPI ports
- ☐ Leave at least 2" of clearance behind the guestroom TV
- ☐ Use an articulating TV wall mount (if wall mounted)

ROOM CONTROLS

- ☐ Install Connected Room-compatible thermostats in all guestrooms*
- ☐ Install Connected Room-compatible light switches in guestroom living and sleeping areas where no master switch is present*
- ☐ Outfit all light switches with a neutral wire

**All hotels procuring or replacing thermostats or lighting controls should only invest in Connected Room compatible devices in preparation for future standards; all Motto by Hilton hotels are required to install Connected Room compatible thermostats and lighting controls.*
