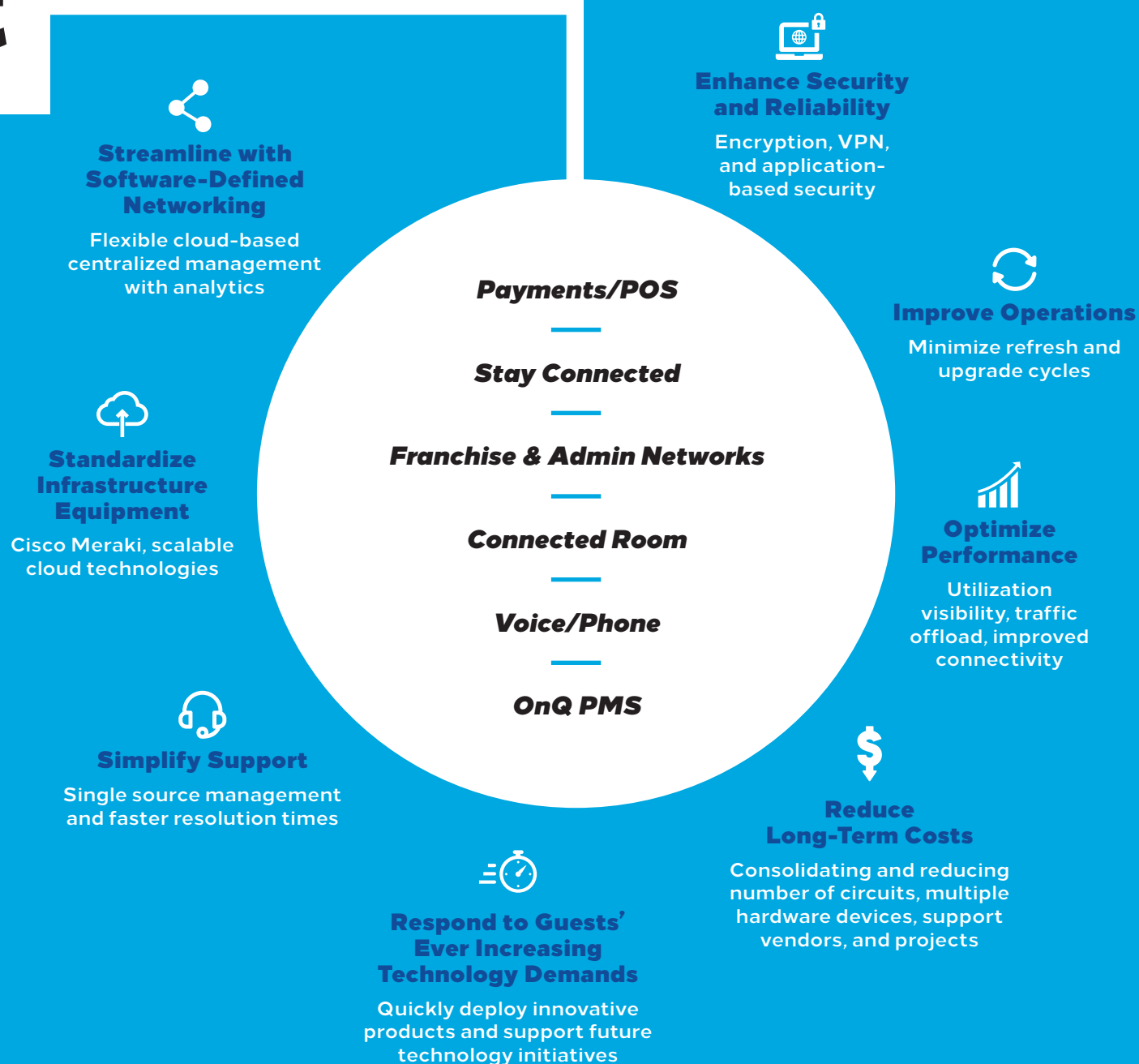

### UnoNet will enable Property-level cost savings by:

- Consolidating and reducing the number of circuits and independent networks installed in the Back of House for the admin network (Delphi, payment/POS systems, Team Member use, etc.); for the PMS network; and in the guest areas for internet access, voice systems, TV streaming, and Internet of Things
- Lowering project costs by minimizing refresh cycles and individual vendors needed to come on property to perform equipment and networks upgrades
- Lowering support costs by removing the need for multiple vendors to support individual networks, resulting in less downtime for troubleshooting and remediation
- Lowering equipment costs by utilizing software defined networking to manage network traffic centrally and remove proprietary circuits
- Increasing an owner's ability to select an Internet Service Provider that best meets his/her hotel's needs
